

Property & Finance Highlights

May 13, 2014

- Memorial Gardens: discussed repair and/or reordering of broken or missing memorial signs, as well as discussion on shrubs or trees needing replacement and/or moving. Placed on a “to do” list: building of three or four wooden steps and a landing from lawn to the Shirley-Dawn Jorgenson garden. A general work day has been held.
- Flooring: we learned that our flooring contact, Madison Carpets, will not accept liability for lock-solid tiles laid over loose asbestos tiles in the lounge, and was not interested in giving a bid for the basement hallway for the same reason. We will obtain a bid for removal of asbestos tiles in the lounge (Madison Carpets does not do this kind of work). Removal of these tiles would allow sheet vinyl installation as a possibility. Note: the old floor scrubbing machine has been disposed of.
- Audit: preparation for the audit (covering years 2011, 2012, 2013) will continue this month.
- Peace Pole: having met with the garden designer, we forwarded to session a garden plan to see if the concept is acceptable; if so, a cost figure will be obtained from the designer.
- Concourse ceiling repair: work will probably begin in late May.
- Drainage: discussed downspout, asphalt, low areas, drain tiling, culvert repairs, and removing the garbage corral.
- Lawn: Boley has repaired snow-plowing damage to lawn. The lawnmower is tuned up.
- Safety: a reminder that the basement of the church is our tornado shelter.
- Fire alarm system: Tyco has told us to expect changes after June 1 and we are awaiting further info.
- Financials: the committee reviewed reports as of 4/30/14. Net income is over budgeted net income.
- Next meeting: Tuesday, June 10, 7pm.

May 4, 2014

- Heard that May 29th is the last choir rehearsal (with potluck), with June 1 the last Sunday in the loft.
- Congratulated Maggie on her 10th anniversary at DHPC in the first week of June.
- Learned summer music recruitment has started, with Elizabeth Holland and June Zeeh volunteering at the meeting.
- The annual hymn festival is scheduled for June 15; no pulpit supply needed.
- Heard that Maggie will be on vacation May 18 with Tom Jones subbing, and on June 29 with June Zeeh subbing.

- Decided the Pentecost service on June 8 will be held indoors. Congregation asked to wear red.

- Next meeting date tentatively set for September 7, 2014 subject to change by stated supply pastor.

***May Outreach Potluck
Presented by WCCN
Sunday, May 18th***

On Sunday, May 18th, Jeanne Duffy was with us from Working Capital for Community Needs to present our May potluck. Jeanne did an exceptional job of describing the work, objectives and accomplishments of Working Capital for Community Needs (WCCN), an organization that we have supported through the Outreach budget for many years. It was formerly known as Wisconsin Coordinating Council on Nicaragua.

WCCN is a non-profit organization which empowers low-income Latin American entrepreneurs and small-scale farmers through access to microcredit and fair trade markets. Now in its 30th anniversary, WCCN is still providing affordable financing in Nicaragua and has expanded lending to Guatemala, El Salvador, Honduras, Ecuador, and Peru.

We heard some amazing facts released since 2013:

- 72% of microloan recipients were women
- \$3 million was invested in 7 fair trade coffee cooperatives
- \$90 million invested since 1991
- The average loan size to a micro entrepreneur is \$945!

WCCN is supported by over 2200 individual investors and 48 institutional investors of which Dale Heights is one. The process begins with North American donors and investors giving to WCCN's Capital for Communities Fund. WCCN then lends money to Partner Microfinance Institution and Agricultural Cooperatives in 6 countries who then loan that money to women, the rural poor, and micro entrepreneurs. Entrepreneurs and farmers, especially women, increase their income, pay back their loans, and expand their businesses. WCCN's Partners repay WCCN, North American investors make a modest return, and WCCN increases its impact by loaning out more funds.
